Jostens Summer Workshop Code of Conduct

Please read carefully each of the items listed below. In order to make sure our camp provides a safe, positive atmosphere for all in attendance, we require that all campers follow the rules as set forth herein. Failure to comply with any of the items listed in the Code of Conduct will result in the camper being sent home immediately at the parent/guardian's expense. Campers sent home early will not be entitled to a refund of any portion of camp or travel fees.

- 1) No alcohol, tobacco products or illegal drugs are allowed at the workshop. The Jostens Summer Yearbook Workshop is a nonsmoking workshop. Any campers needing prescription medication must bring written consent and directions for use signed by a parent or guardian. This information must be presented to the workshop office staff at registration.
- 2) Campers will refrain from using profanity or obscene language.
- 3) Campers are required to attend all sessions and are required to be in their assigned locations at all times.
- 4) Campers are not allowed to leave the University of San Diego unless as part of a specified group activity chaperoned by an adult. Students who drive themselves to camp are required to complete the Vehicle Waiver Form to purchase a parking pass. Jostens requires that all students remain on campus throughout the duration of Jostens' workshop. All student drivers will adhere to the requirements listed on the waiver. If a student driver leaves the USD campus without permission from his/her adviser, chaperone or the workshop director, Tina Cleavelin, the student's parents will be contacted and the student will be sent home immediately.
- 5) Campers are expected to dress appropriately and conservatively in accordance with traditional school dress codes.
- 6) Campers must be quiet and in their assigned beds at "lights out" each evening. The time will be designated on the schedule students receive upon registration.
- 7) Boys and girls will be assigned separate sleeping quarters. Members of the opposite sex are NOT ALLOWED to meet together in areas designated as sleeping areas. Simply put, no boys are allowed in girls' rooms and no girls are allowed in boys' rooms for any reason at ANY time.
- 8) Campers will behave in a respectful manner to all campers, camp staff and USD staff.
- 9) No public displays of affection between campers are allowed.
